This module will be of particular interest to individuals wanting to upskill their colleagues to provide expert practice. Previous experience of training delivery is beneficial in this role.

Students will gain:

- Knowledge about the original research contributing to this model, from staff directly involved in the study.
- Confidence in understanding and applying an evidence based approach to supporting people with complex needs.
- Successful completion of this module will enable participants to become a Dementia Practice Development Coach (DPDC) for their own organisation and implement the FITS programme into practice.
