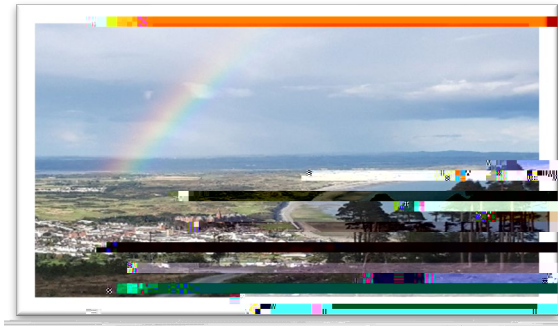


Engagement and Empowerment in Dementia Studies (MDEM4006)

Engagement and Empowerment in Dementia Studies is a Module which forms part of the Post Graduate Certificate in Dementia Studies, hosted at the University of Worcester (UK), and can be studied as a standalone option (with 15 Credits at Level 7). It is provided fully online, via distance learning, and includes regular live tutorials.

Learning is focused upon the human rights and citizenship of people affected by dementia, *vital components of everyday life*. It is about:

- Understanding what engagement and empowerment really mean for people living with dementia; preserving and promoting the fundamental rights of individuals.

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
