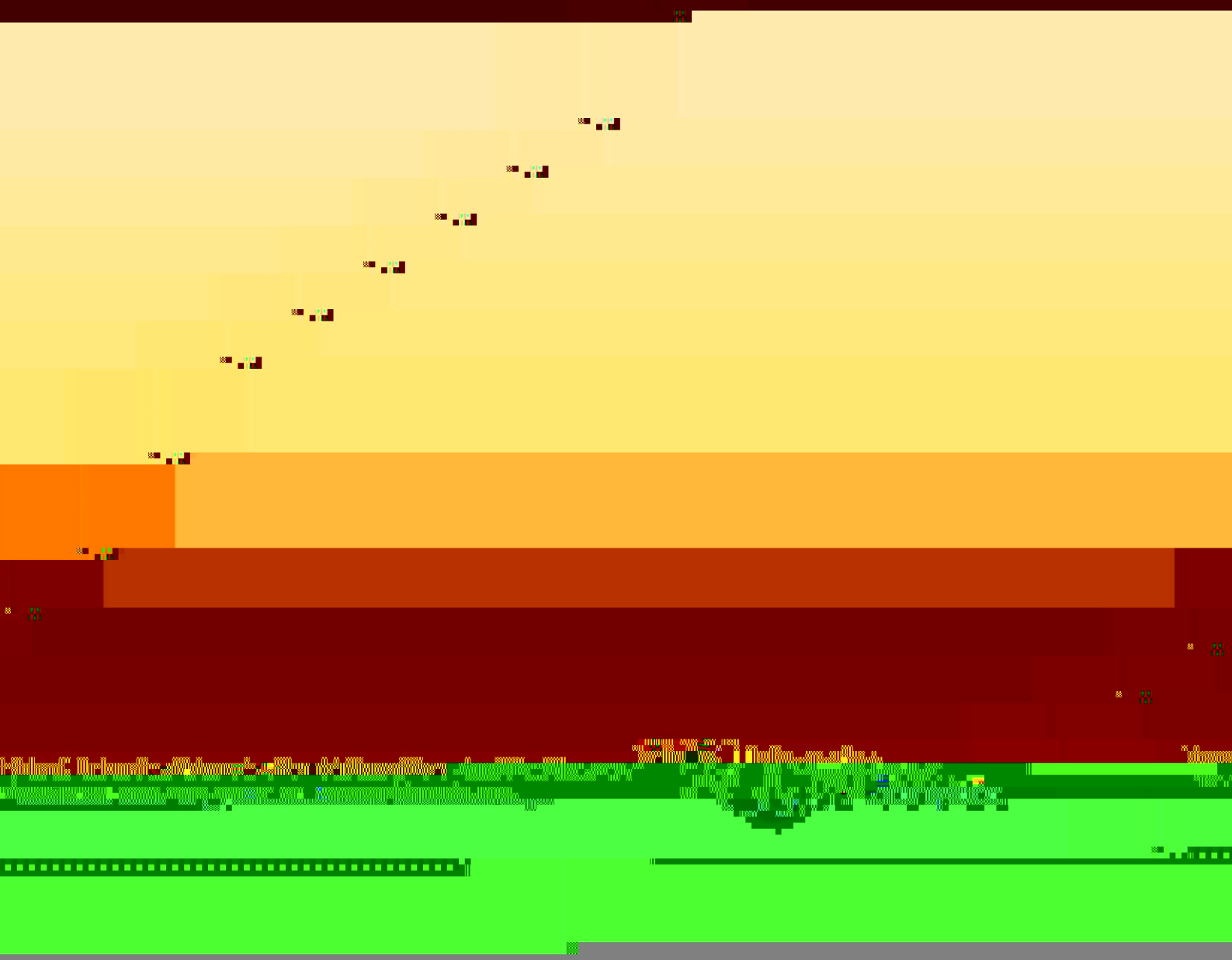

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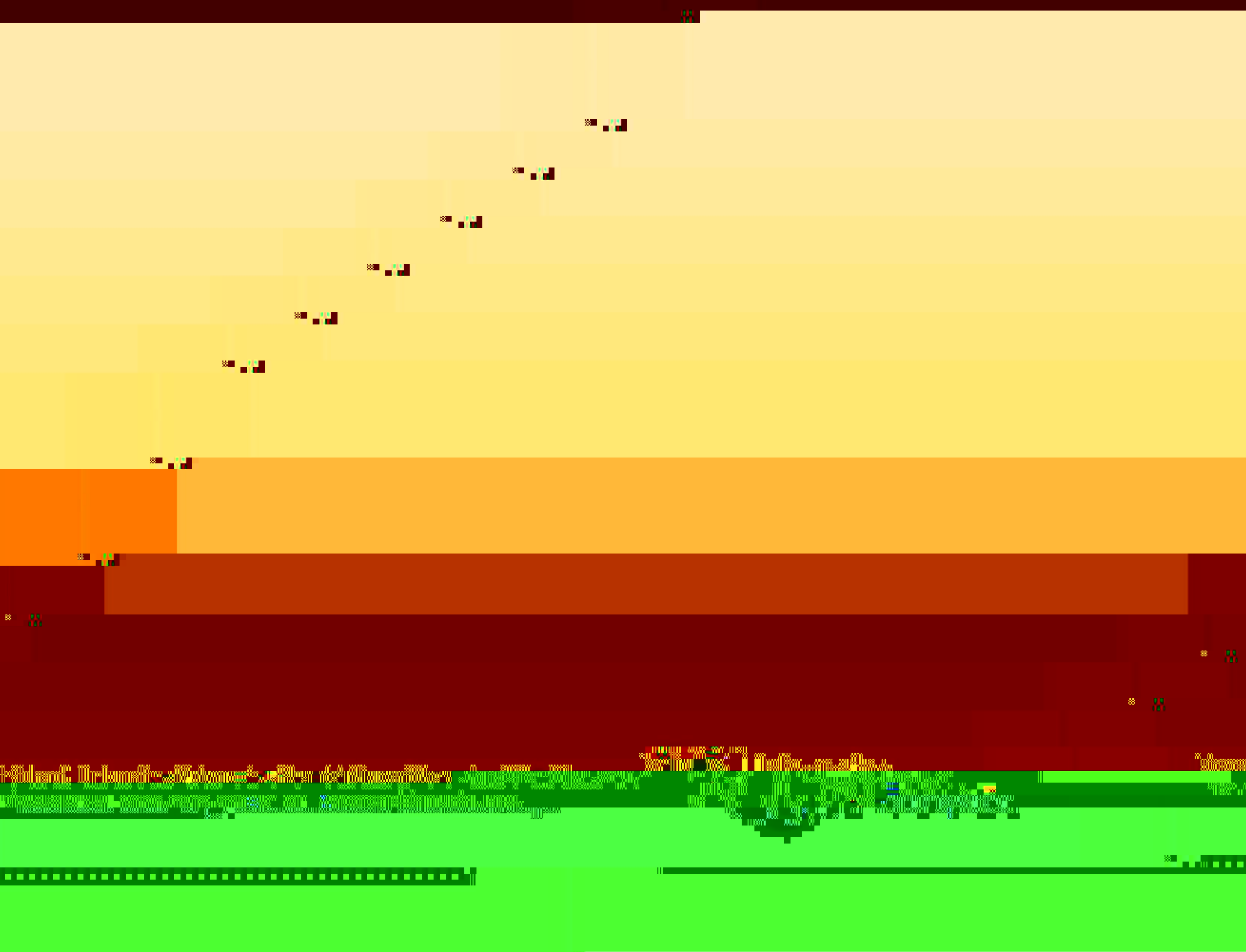
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The University hence focuses its research around five high-level challenges facing society, locally, nationally and globally
